Invitation to 30th European Xiangqi Championship Munich, 28-29.01.2017

Authorised by the European Xiangqi Federation (EXF), the German Xiangqi Association (DXB) will organize the 30th European Xiangqi Championship in Munich on 28-29 January 2017. The tournament is also the qualifier of the 9th Hanxin Cup Xiangqi International Masters. The individual champion and the winner of NCNV Group will be entitled to represent EXF to participate in the Hanxin Cup which is expected to be held in Huaiyin, China in 2017.

It is scheduled that the European Xiangqi Federation (EXF) will be officially registered in Munich Notary. The appointment will be at 15:00 on Friday 27.01.2017 in Goerk Berringer Notare, Karsplatz 10, D-80335 Munich. Each EU country are welcome to send a representative to be the founding members of EXF.

The tournament happens to be held on the first day of the Chinese New Year Rooster. Therefore the organizer DXB will invite all the participants to attend a grand Gala of the opening ceremony in the Munich Folklore Museum Theater on the evening of Jan.28, to enjoy a performance of Chinese traditional dance and music and meanwhile celebrate the official registration of EXF.

The 30th European Xiangqi Championship promises to be a great milestone of Xiangqi globalization. All the friends and Xiangqi fans in EU are invited to the tournament.

Taxis and Airport Express Bus are readily available at Munich International Airport (MUC) outside the airport's Terminal 1 and Terminal 2. The journey from MUC to the city center of Munich will take around 40 minutes with the fare of 80 €. For public transportation the S-Bahn (S1 or S8) will lead directly from MUC to Hirschgarten (Juli Restaurant) or Donnersbergerbruecke (Hotel Hahn). The single ticket will cost 10.4 €. It is advised to buy a Day Ticket Airport Single for 12 € or Day Ticket Airport Group of 2-5 passengers for 20 €.
